Discovery Spring Camp General Information 2018

PRICING

Member \$100/week
Non-Member \$110/week

Discovery Spring Camp is designed for children *enrolled* in Kindergarten through Grade 3.

HOURS

9:00am – 12:00pm

We offer a 15 minute window to drop-off and pick-up your camper. A \$10 penalty fee is due upon children arriving before 8:45am or leaving after 12:15pm.

DROP-OFF is between 8:45am – 9:00pm

Upon arrival, sign-in your camper at the Welcome Garden, located to the left of the front entrance, or Indoor Classroom during inclement weather. Programming will begin promptly, so please have camper arrive on time.

If you will arrive late, please leave a message at 760.233.7755 with your camper's name and their expected time of arrival or pick-up.

PICK-UP is at 12:00pm

You must sign-out your camper each day at the Welcome Garden, or Indoor Classroom during inclement weather. You or a preauthorized adult picking up your camper **MUST HAVE A PICTURE ID**. Curbside parking is allowed for *pick-up only* if the parking lot is full.

Your camper will not be released to an adult that is not on your alternative departure list or to anyone that does not have a picture ID.

If no one has picked up your camper by 12:15PM, we will call your emergency and/or alternative departure contacts and you will be charged a \$10 penalty fee.

REFUND POLICY

Cancellations made within 2 weeks of camp will receive a partial refund of 50% of payment. No refund is available on the day of the camp.

Sessions with less than 6 campers may be cancelled. You will be notified 1 week prior to camp and receive a full refund.

FOOD

Snack will NOT be provided. Please pack a snack and a drink for each day your camper comes to camp. Please note that we are a *peanut-free* facility.

CLOTHING

Dress your camper comfortably and in clothing appropriate for them to have messy fun. Prepare your child for potential outdoor activities as well (i.e. hat, jacket, sunscreen, etc.). Label everything with your child's name.

VALUABLES

We discourage children from bringing any valuables to the Museum. SDCDM will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATION POLICY

Discovery Camp has basic rules of behavior, including respecting others, Museum exhibits, and camp materials. Disrespectful behavior, foul or hurtful language, and violence will not be tolerated. SDCDM reserves the right to ask campers not to return to camp without refund.

DAILY MEDICATION

Please send only those medications that absolutely must be taken during camp hours (i.e. if it can be taken before or after camp, please make all effort to do so). Required medication must be placed in a Ziploc bag and clearly labeled with both the child's name and dosage. Please list the details in the HEALTH FORM explaining what the medication is for, when and how it should be dispensed, and any specific storage information.

FREE MUSEUM ADMISSION

Feel free to enjoy the Museum after camp! Your child and one adult (you or an authorized adult) will get free admission on registered camp days. General admission fees apply to additional children and adults.
