

Birthday Party Frequently Asked Questions

- **Who is counted in the Party guest count?**
 - All adults and children are counted towards the final guest count. However, the Birthday Party child(ren) and any children under the age of 12 months old are not counted.
- **Can I bring food?**
 - Yes! You are welcome to bring any food you would like with the exception of foods containing peanuts. **SDCDM is a peanut free facility.**
- **Are decorations provided?**
 - We provide table cloths and minimal decorations. This includes a sign with the birthday child(ren)'s name(s). You are welcome to bring additional decorations and will be provided assistance in setting up and taking down by our Birthday Party Assistants.
- **Are the Birthday Party themes geared towards certain ages?**
 - SDCDM focuses on children 10 years old and younger. Our Party assistants are trained to facilitate workshops for any theme and any age within this range.
- **How is payment collected?**
 - Upon registering for a Birthday Party, we ask for an estimated guest count. We base an initial price estimate on this number. Payment will not be collected until a final headcount is taken at the end of your party and you will be charged based on these final numbers.
