

## Girl Scouts Workshop General Information 2016-2017

### PRICING

**Workshop**                    \$12/scout  
                                     Adults Free of Charge

Workshop fees include General Admission.

### PAYMENT

**A \$50 refundable registration deposit is required.**

Payment for Workshop fees is due on the date of the visit.

### GROUP SIZE

We require one chaperone per ten children.  
Failure to provide an adequate number of chaperones will result in a penalty charge of \$50 per absent adult.

Workshops are designed for a minimum of 10 scouts and a maximum of 30 scouts.

Workshops with less than 10 scouts may be cancelled. You will be notified 1 week prior to the workshop and receive a full refund on your registration deposit.

### WORKSHOPS

Our hands-on workshops align to Girl Scout Daisy and Brownie journey and badge requirements. A free SDCDM patch is available upon workshop completion.

Workshops are 1.25 hours unless otherwise noted.

Most Workshops are also available as Mobile Workshops, modified to be hosted at your site or location.

### HOURS

The Museum is open daily from 9:30am-4:30pm.

Workshops are held on specific dates or by request. Please contact us for additional days.

### REGISTRATION POLICY

Registration must be made *at least two weeks* in advance. Register online along with a refundable \$50 registration deposit.

Once the registration form and deposit are received and processed, we will send a confirmation email within 2 business days.

### CANCELLATION POLICY

We require at least 2 week notice for cancellations to receive a full refund on the registration deposit.

Cancellations made within 2 weeks of workshop date will not receive a refund.

### PARKING

Parking is located adjacent to the Museum. Overflow parking is available at the Center for the Arts, Escondido.

### ARRIVAL

*Arrive 15 minutes before the workshop begins.*

The group should wait in the Welcome Garden, located to the left of the entrance.

Have one adult check-in at the Front Desk with an accurate headcount for children and adults and make your payment at this time.

Once all groups are checked-in, Museum staff will meet all groups outside in the Welcome Garden and go over the Museum rules.

Bathrooms are located behind the store, in the main hallway. The boys and girls restrooms are equipped with multi-stalls.

## PHOTOGRAPHY

Photography or videography may occur during workshops for Museum use. Please indicate which children may not participate prior to workshop.

## GUIDELINES

Please read the following list of guidelines and share them with your group prior to your visit.

- Adults should model good behavior for the group and remain with group at all times.
- Use your indoor voice when at the Museum.
- No pushing, running, or rough play.
- Children are not allowed unaccompanied in the restroom or other areas of the Museum.
- Keep your shoes on.
- Do not bring any peanuts or peanut-related products into the Museum.
- You are free to play in all exhibit areas of the Museum except the Museum Gift Shop.

If the group cannot comply with the rules, Museum staff may dismiss a troop or end the workshop.
