San Diego Children's Discovery Museum strengthens parent and child bonds through new "Growing Together!" classes

(Escondido, CA – September 18, 2019) With older children back in school, San Diego Children's Discovery Museum is proud to offer new interactive music, dance, and storytelling classes for children ages 0 to 36 months and caregivers to bond and learn together.

Each 30 to 45-minute class incorporates song, music, storytime and collaborative peer-to-peer activities. The program is designed for pairs of one caregiver and one child, and targets developmental milestones specific to ages 1 and 2.

On Fridays, children ages 0 to 23 months ("Little Ones") learn social skills and build literacy abilities together; on Wednesdays, children ages 24-36 months ("Toddlin' Twos") strengthen motor skills and socio-emotional understandings. Participants are able to socialize with peers of their age and develop peer-to-peer communication and social skills in a small group setting, with strong parent participation. The program is hosted in the morning, before the Museum opens to the general public.
