

## Group Play General Information

### PRICING

**Group Play**                 \$5/person  
                                      1 Adult/10 Children Free

We require one chaperone per ten children. Failure to provide an adequate number of chaperones will result in a penalty charge of \$50 per absent adult.

Payment is due on the date of the visit.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

We offer scholarships for Title-I and low-income schools and youth organizations, subject to availability.

Scholarships are for Group Play admission and/or transportation.

### GROUP SIZE

Group Play is for groups of 10 or more with a limit of 35 people.

For groups of 35 or more, please call to discuss options.

### REGISTRATION POLICY

Registration must be made *at least two weeks* in advance. Register online or fill out a Group Play Registration Form with multiple date and start time options.

Once the registration form is received and processed, we will send a confirmation email within 2 business days.

### CANCELLATION POLICY

We request at least a 48 hour notice for all cancellations.

### PHOTOGRAPHY

Photography or videography may occur during Group Play for Museum use. Please indicate which children may not participate prior to workshop.

### HOURS

The Museum is open daily from 9:30am-4:30pm.

Group Play may be scheduled during any day or time the Museum is open.

### FOOD AND EATING

We are a peanut-free facility. Please do not bring peanuts or peanut-related products inside the Museum.

Please collect lunches from children before you arrive at the Museum.

Lockers are available to rent. Inquire at the Front Desk.

### EATING LOCATIONS

Snack or lunch may be eaten at the Museum or across the street at Grape Day Park.

Eating areas include the picnic benches in the Children's Discovery Garden or the indoor classroom. *Seating is first come, first served.*

The Children's Discovery Garden has picnic benches and several smaller eating areas. The indoor classroom has tables as well. You may use one or both locations if available.

Grape Day Park is the most popular eating location option with groups of 40 or more. You will have in and out privileges all day.

### MUSEUM STORE

We request that the children do not purchase anything at the Museum store during their group visit.

There is complimentary hot coffee and a small selection of healthy food and beverage items for sale.

### BATHROOMS

Bathrooms are located behind the store, in the main hallway. The boys and girls restrooms are equipped with multi-stalls.

## PARKING

Parking is located adjacent to the museum. Buses may park alongside the Museum entrance for loading and unloading.

## ARRIVAL

The group should wait in the Welcome Garden, located to the left of the entrance.

Have one teacher check-in at the front desk. Once the teacher has checked in, Museum staff will meet your group outside and go over the Museum rules.

## CHECK-IN

*Check-in 15 minutes before the workshop begins.*

Check-in at the front desk with an accurate headcount for students and adults. You will also make your payment at this time.

## GUIDELINES

Please read the following list of guidelines and share them with your group prior to the visit:

- Teachers and chaperones should model good behavior for the group and remain with students at all times.
- Use your indoor voice when at the Museum.
- No pushing, running, or rough play.
- Children are not allowed unaccompanied in the restroom or other areas of the Museum.
- Keep your shoes on.
- Do not bring any peanuts or peanut-related products into the Museum.
- You are free to play in all exhibit areas of the Museum except the Museum Gift Shop.

If the group cannot comply with the rules, Museum staff may end Group Play.
